

Step 1: Classroom

The teen program starts with a 3-week or 4-week class. After passing the permit test, we will issue the certificate needed to receive the learner permit from the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS).

Step 2: Schedule Appointment

- Schedule your DPS appointment at <u>public.txdpsscheduler.com/</u>
- Select Service "Apply for First time Texas DL/Permit"
- Appointments can be scheduled at ANY DPS location in Texas
- It is highly recommended to begin searching for an appointment. Students can begin going to DPS as early as the second week of class. However, DPS appointments are typically booked 1–2 months in advance, depending on location.
- DPS offices in smaller cities, typically have sooner availability

Step 3: In-Car Lessons

- Teens must have the Texas DPS-issued learner permit, with their photo, BEFORE they can start the in-car driving lessons.
- Driving appointments will be completed in a driving school vehicle, with a passenger-side brake.
- Students schedule driving lessons through their student account. Students are required to bring their learner permit & wear a mask during their driving sessions.
- Students must complete 30-hours of practice at home with a Texas licensed adult driver.





Prior to scheduling the road test, Teens must:

- Hold a Texas learner permit for 6-months. Refer to date on back of learner permit
- Completed the Teen classroom & driving portions of drivers ed
- Be at least 16 years old
- Complete the Impact Texas Teen Driver Program

Students must bring an insured vehicle to complete the road test. The list of documents needed for the Road test are listed on the <u>DPS Road Test</u> tab
